

Report on School Visit, 26th November

Introduction:

Regular school visits are carried out by the trainees of PiE to strengthen the relationship between the PiE and the schools from which the students come to attend the PiE program. On 26 November, the trainees visited Viswa Niketan Higher Secondary School at Thapathali for the same purpose.

Objectives:

- To cement a fruitful relationship with the school administration
- To promote the value of PiE
- To encourage needy students to join PiE

Activities:

Trainees did the following activities:

1. Talked with the Head Teacher and other teachers about PiE
2. Gathered the students and encouraged those who had stopped coming to PiE to rejoin PiE
3. Listened to the problems faced by the children in attending PiE
4. Discussed possible solutions with the students.

Findings:

- The school family is still apprehensive about PiE.
- Around half of the irregular students are interested to rejoin PIE
- Among the irregular students, most of the students have to work in the morning; some of them are far from PIE and a few are lazy to come.
- There are around 90 students in Vishwa Niketan Higher Secondary School who come to PIE (including regular and irregular)
- There are only a few students from settlement area

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
