

# NOTICE FOR A-LEVEL BATCH OF 2014-2016 AND PLUS-TWO BATCH OF 2014 -2016

Webster University Thailand is offering full scholarship for one student (100 % - tuition fees only) and partial scholarship to three students, (50% - tuition fees only) for undergraduate programs in Management and Humanities.

The students are selected on the basis of their GPA (the higher the GPA, the better the chance) or in the case of Plus Two, 75% and above and on the basis of their performance in an entrance test of three hours (similar to TOEFL, ILTS etc. that includes listening, reading and comprehension) which will be conducted on the 7th of July in Kathmandu. (The exact venue would be notified later.)

3. Students from many different schools will be competing in the entrance test, and only the top four students will be selected for the scholarship.
4. The scholarship program is sponsored by Chaudhari Group, Nepal.
5. The A-Level students, if selected, have a better advantage as their grades could be transferred and thus can save almost one year.
6. The selected students have an option to study their second, third and fourth years in any other Webster University College in the world with the same fees.
7. For students whose results are not yet out, they only need to submit their class 11 Marks or AS marks and their Class 12 send up results or A2 Send up Marks.
8. The last date for the application is 1 July. The Webster University Thailand accepts any number of applications.
